# Benzodiazepines "Benzos"



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Benzodiazepines are depressants that are prescribed to induce sleep, relieve anxiety and muscle spasms, and prevent seizures.

## Commonly Prescribed Benzos



- Xanax ("Bars")
- Klonopin ("K-Pins")
- Ativan
- Valium



## Symptoms of Use:

- Drowsiness
- Blurred Vision
- Slurred Speech
- Dry Mouth
- Confusion
- Lack of Coordination

**A person can overdose on a benzodiazepine. Overdose results in respiratory arrest.**

## Symptoms of Overdose:

- Slow, shallow, or stopped breathing
- Cool, clammy skin
- Unconsciousness
- Blue tint around the ears/lips

Often benzodiazepines are misused in combination with alcohol/opioids. Mixing two depressants **highly** increases the likelihood of overdose.



**Narcan (Naloxone) will not reverse a benzodiazepine overdose.**

Benzodiazepines are a drug of tolerance.

Withdrawal symptoms include anxiety, panic, irritability, insomnia and more.
